



## Fitzwilliam College, University of Cambridge Batista i Roca Fellowship in Catalan Studies

Fitzwilliam College, Cambridge invites applications for a Research Fellowship, to be held for the academical year 2009-10, in any field consistent with the wishes of Batista i Roca (who endowed it with a view to supporting candidates whose work or career has some subsequent application to the society of the Catalan-speaking regions, especially in the fields of public or academic life). The Fellow will be a Catalan speaker, normally at an early stage in his or her career engaged in an independent research project which will be advanced by a period in Cambridge. The holder is not permitted to register for any diploma or higher degree at either the University of Cambridge or any other British university.

The stipend is currently set at : pre-PhD £16,215 - £18,701 / post PhD £17,667 - £19,841. In addition, the Fellow will be entitled to occupy free of charge a College room and to take all meals in College without charge when the kitchens are open.

Applicants should send a detailed statement of their research proposal (not exceeding 1,000 words), a copy of their *curriculum vitae* and the name of three referees. Candidates should ask their referees to ensure that their references reach the Master **by 30 April**. It is the candidate's responsibility to arrange for this: the College will not request references from referees. Selected candidates will be called for interview on **5 June**, and reasonable claims for expenses will be reimbursed. *All material must be submitted in English* and candidates will be required to demonstrate a knowledge of it at a level sufficient to be able to benefit from the award.
