

Annual Conference 2006: Accommodation Options

There are two options situated on campus which should be booked through the University as this will give you discounted rates. They are:

Lancaster House Hotel

Discounted prices from £79 en-suite single (bed & breakfast)

4 star hotel with 'superb modern facilities and traditional comfort'. Right next to the University Campus and the venue for the Annual Lunch. All bills to be settled directly with the hotel prior to departure.

Campus Guest Room

Discounted prices from £22 en-suite single (room only)

A number of rooms have been reserved for our use. These are primarily intended for students, lectors etc. but if you do not fall into this category and are interested in a campus room please let us know as we may be able to accommodate you by booking further rooms (if available). You will be asked to pay for these rooms by cheque at the time of booking.

Other hotels and guest houses are available in the local area, either in the city centre or in nearby villages. (Prices from £32.50 upwards.) There are good bus links from the University to the town centre (every 10-20 minutes roughly 7am-midnight), but if you choose to stay outside the centre you will need a car.

The Lancashire Conference Office has provided details of some of the most suitable options and has offered to make the bookings for us. If you want to take advantage of this all you need to do is send them the completed booking form. The map of the city centre they have provided shows the locations of some of the hotels.
